

# VERB CONJUGATION

Conjugation means matching the **\_verb\_** and **\_the subject\_**.

Examples in English;

\_\_\_\_\_ **he + to run > he runs** \_\_\_\_\_ **she + to play > she plays** \_\_\_\_\_

The subjects in Spanish are;

<b>Yo</b>	<b>I</b>	<b>Nosotros</b>	<b>We</b>
		<b>Nosotras</b>	
<b>Tú</b>	<b>You familiar</b>	<b>Vosotros</b>	<b>You familiar pl.</b>
		<b>Vosotras</b>	
<b>Él / Ella</b>	<b>He / She</b>	<b>Ellos / Ellas</b>	<b>They</b>
<b>Usted</b>	<b>You formal</b>	<b>Ustedes</b>	<b>You formal pl.</b>

There are 3 kinds of verbs in Spanish; **-ar**, **-er**, & **-ir**.

The endings for **\_\_\_-ar\_\_\_** verbs are;

Yo	<b>o</b>	Nosotros	<b>amos</b>
Tú	<b>as</b>	Vosotros	<b>áis</b>
Él / Ella	<b>a</b>	Ellos / Ellas	<b>an</b>
Usted		Ustedes	

The endings for **\_\_\_-er\_\_\_** verbs are;

Yo	<b>o</b>	Nosotros	<b>emos</b>
Tú	<b>es</b>	Vosotros	<b>éis</b>
Él / Ella	<b>e</b>	Ellos / Ellas	<b>en</b>
Usted		Ustedes	

The endings for **-ir** verbs are;

Yo	<b>o</b>	Nosotros	<b>imos</b>
Tú	<b>es</b>	Vosotros	<b>ís</b>
Él / Ella Usted	<b>e</b>	Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	<b>en</b>

There are 2 steps to conjugate a verb, the same as in **English**.

1. Remove the "to" which is the **-ar, -er, or -ir** at the end of the verb in Spanish.
2. Add the ending which matches the subject like how we add "s" for he/she in Eng.

Example **-er** verb; **comer, to eat**

Yo	<b>como</b> I eat	Nosotros	<b>comemos</b> We eat
Tú	<b>comes</b> You eat (familiar)	Vosotros	<b>coméis</b> You eat (old pl.)
Él / Ella Usted	<b>come</b> He/She eats You eat (formal)	Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	<b>comen</b> They eat You eat (plural)

Example **-ir** verb; **vivir, to live**

Yo	<b>vivo</b> I live	Nosotros	<b>vivimos</b> We live
Tú	<b>vives</b> You live (familiar)	Vosotros	<b>vivís</b> You live (old pl.)
Él / Ella Usted	<b>vive</b> He/She lives You live (formal)	Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	<b>viven</b> They live You live (plural)
