## **PREPOSITIONAL PRONOUNS**

When using prepositions like **for** (para), **of / from** (de), **with** (con), or **to** (a) you must use a special set of pronouns. They are similar to the subject pronouns except for me and you. They are:

Me = Mí	Us = Nosotros
You (fam.) = <b>Ti</b>	You (fam. pl.) = Vosotros
Him = Él	Them = Ellos
Her = Ella	Ellas
You (for.) = Usted	You (for. pl.) = <b>Ustedes</b>

When using me or you (fam.) with con, there is an irregularity.

Con + mí > conmigo.

Con + ti > contigo.

Examples:

I left with you. = Yo salí contigo.

Do you have something for me. = ¿Tienes algo para mí?

The letter is from her. = La carta es de ella.

They play with us. = Ellos juegan con nosotros.
